TOPIC: North Resident Deputies

DETAILS: In an effort to provide both the most expedient and the greatest quality of law enforcement service available, the Humboldt County Sheriff's Office has three deputies assigned to exclusively patrol the very large portion of Humboldt County that sits from roughly north of Highway 140 (the Denio road) all the way to the Oregon state line. It is the sole responsibility of these three deputies to handle all law enforcement functions for the Sheriff's Office as well as interacting with the communities of McDermitt, Orovada, Kings River, and Denio.

The three North County Deputies are:

Deputy Kyle Negus

Deputy Negus has been with the Sheriff's Office for just short of two years. He is a graduate from the Northern Nevada Law Enforcement Academy located in Reno. Deputy Negus grew up in Lake County Oregon. Negus is a member of the Sheriff's Office Special Response Team as well as being a certified member of the new off-road enforcement team. Deputy Negus resides in Orovada.

Deputy Chukuma Jones

Deputy Jones has just recently returned to Humboldt County from the Reno/Sparks area. Deputy Jones is a Lowry High School grad ('94) and also just recently graduated from the State of Nevada P.O.S.T. Academy located in Carson City. Deputy Jones just completed his Field Officer Training Program (FTO) and is now available to respond to calls for service and to patrol the North County area. Deputy Jones resides in Orovada.

Deputy Ken Richardson

Deputy Richardson comes to the H.C.S.O. from the Siskiyou County Sheriff's Office in Northern California. Deputy Richardson has twenty years of law enforcement experience and specializes in livestock enforcement. Before leaving Siskiyou County, Deputy Richardson was a Detective assigned to the Special Investigations Unit. Richardson will be residing in the community of McDermitt.
