DETAILS: Over the last couple of months, there have been some personnel changes within the Sheriff's Office. Humboldt County Sheriff's Sergeant Dave Milton was promoted to the rank of Commander. Commander Milton is responsible for the overall operation of the Humboldt County Detention Center. He supervises the two sergeants, ten deputies, and two civilian personnel that make up the staff at the Center.

January 6, 2012 will mark the final day of service for long time Sergeant Mike Scott who also works inside the Detention Center. Mikes retirement opened up a second vacancy in the sergeant's rank.

In October 2011, Sheriff Kilgore had a sergeant's promotional exam administered to those deputies that were interested and who met the qualifications. Sheriff's deputies Jackie Lynn and Randy Close were selected for promotion by the sheriff.

Sergeant Jackie Lynn assumed her supervisory duties on October 17, 2011. Sergeant Lynn has been with the Sheriff's Office since May of 1997.

Deputy Randy Close will assume his new role as a sergeant on January 8, 2012 after Sergeant Smock retires. Close has been with the agency for five years, coming to the HCSO after nine years with the Nevada Department of Corrections.

Sheriff Kilgore would like to congratulate the three listed personnel on their promotions, and wish them best on all of their future law enforcement endeavors. Kilgore would also like to offer a public thank you to Sergeant Mike Smock for his dedicated service to the Sheriff's Office and wish him well in his upcoming retirement.
